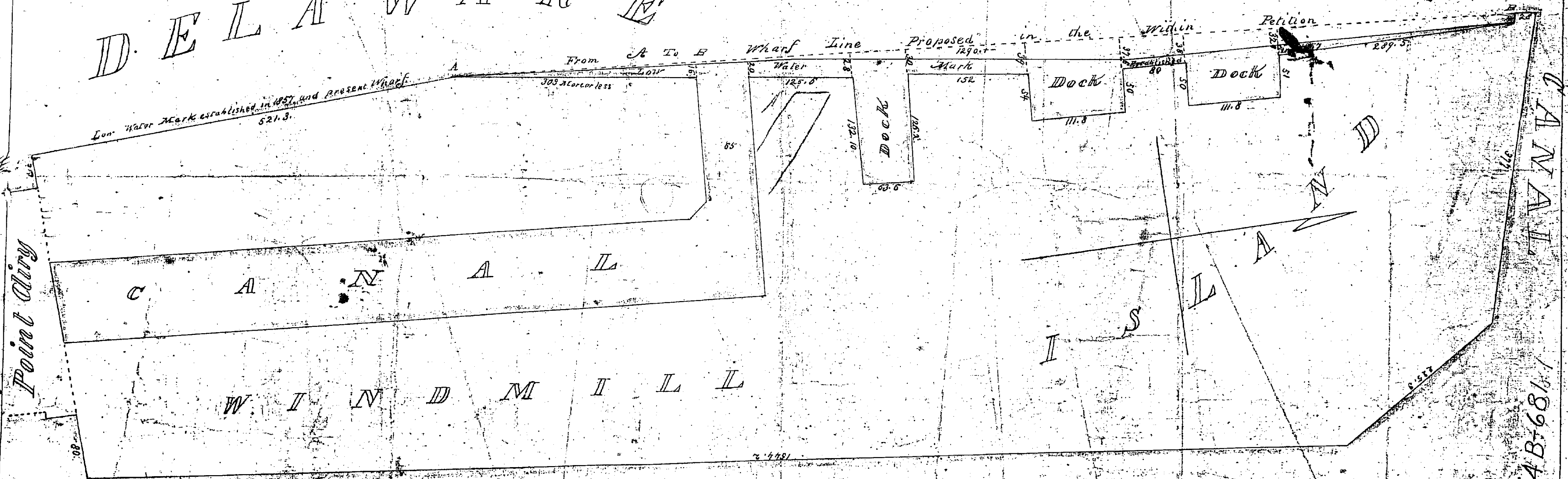

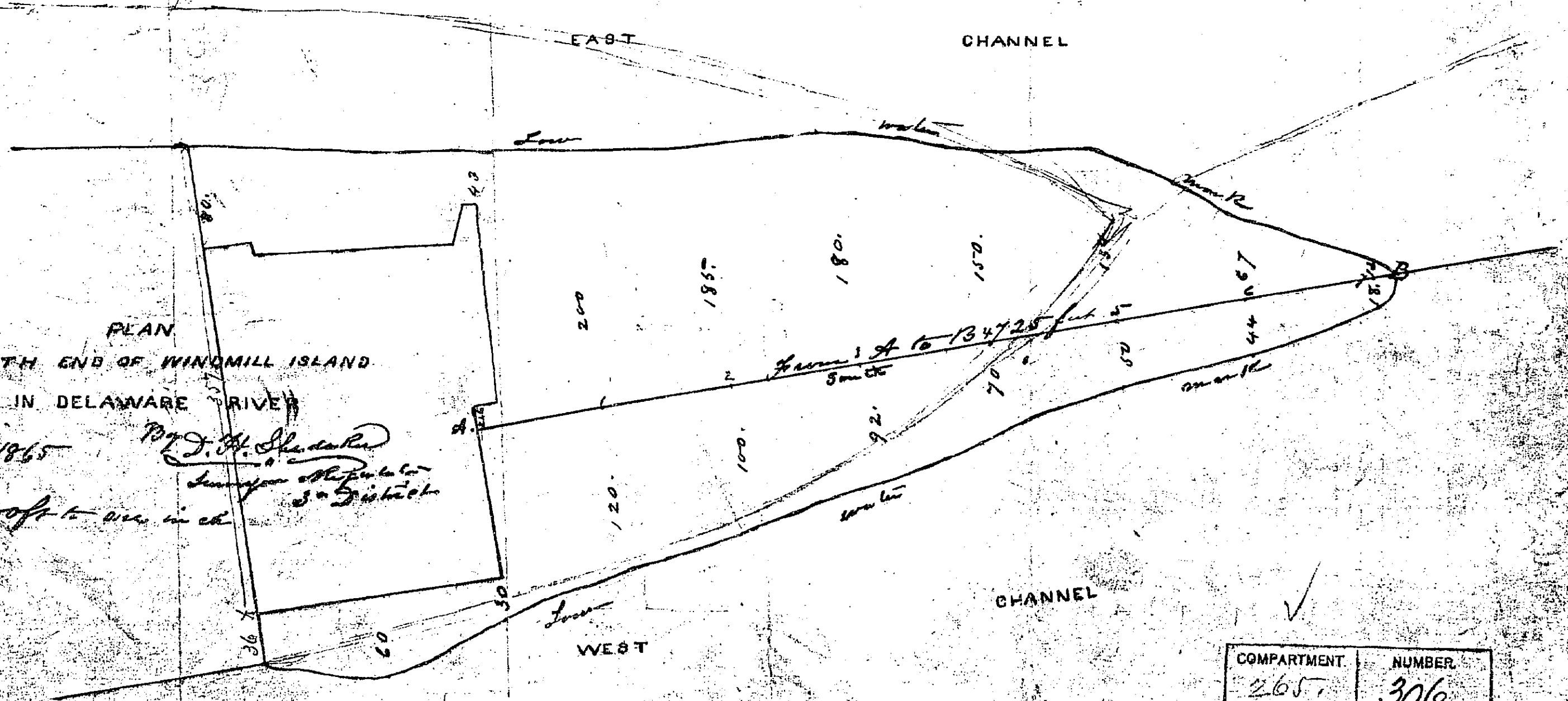
PLAN
